Here's what you need to know and agree to before putting on the goggles:



Are You a Kid or Teen?

- If you are not 18 years old or older, your parent or legal guardian must sign this form for you.
- Children must be at least 10 years of age or 48 inches tall to use the Virtual Reality (VR).

Risk of Use

- Use of virtual reality equipment has known and unanticipated risks which can occur during use and after use to yourself, to property, and to others, including health risks like dizziness, seizures, vision problems, impaired balance and coordination, drowsiness, and motion sickness. If you have any health concerns, do not use this equipment without your doctor's approval.
- We've cleared the space and assigned staff to accompany you during your VR experience, but collisions and other accidents are still possible and our staff are not infallible.
- It may take time to readjust to 'real' reality after your VR experience. Do not perform any activities that may jeopardize your health or safety or the health and safety of others until after you've fully recovered. If you are uncertain if you have fully recovered, ask your doctor first.

Do You Know These Library Rules?

- Using virtual reality while under the influence of drugs or alcohol is strictly prohibited.
- We'll terminate your session for excessive yelling, swearing, disruption or misuse of equipment.
